ORDER MODIFYING OPINION  
[NO CHANGE IN JUDGMENT]

THE COURT:

It is ordered that the opinion filed herein on June 15, 2004, be modified as follows:

1. On page 11 insert a footnote after "*(People v. Morales, supra, 48 Cal.3d at p. 547.)*" The footnote shall read:

After our opinion was filed, Blair asked that we modify the opinion to decide whether the court violated the California Trial Jury Management Act. (Code Civ. Proc., § 190 et seq.) We may not do so. (*California Assn. for Safety Education v. Brown* (1994) 30 Cal.App.4th 1264, 1274-1275.) The issue was not raised by the parties. Moreover, in its response to Blair's request, the Public Defender denies it asked us to decide the issue in its amicus brief.
