ORDER MODIFYING OPINION
NO CHANGE IN JUDGMENT

THE COURT:

It is ordered that the opinion filed herein on November 22, 2006, be modified as follows:

1. On page 5, the last line before section entitled “DISCUSSION”, add the following footnote:

“The District Attorney’s office filed a petition for rehearing in this Court asserting, among other arguments, that the disqualification order was overly broad because it will result in the recusal of over 100 prosecutors. The

record before this court contains no evidence that supports that assertion.”

2. On page 9, first full paragraph, third line from the end, delete the word “so”, so the sentence reads “one-sided in favor of the prosecution and victims”

There is no change in the judgment.
