ON MOTION FOR REHEARING

PER CURIAM.

We grant petitioner's motion for rehearing, and withdraw our prior order denying relief. For the reasons explained in *Lopez v. State*, --- So. 3d ---, 2011 WL 3516143, 5D11-244 (Fla. 5th DCA August 12, 2011) and *Hodges v. State*, 64 So. 3d 142 (Fla. 5th DCA 2011), we grant the petition alleging ineffective assistance of appellate counsel, vacate petitioner's attempted second-degree murder conviction and remand for a new trial. In granting this relief, we rely upon *Burton v. State*, --- So. 3d ----, 2011 WL

1326258, 5D10-1399 (Fla. 5th DCA April 8, 2011), which expressly conflicts with the Fourth District's decision in *Williams v. State*, 40 So.3d 72 (Fla. 4th DCA 2010), *rev. granted*, 64 So.3d 1262 (Fla. 2011). Accordingly, we certify that this opinion also conflicts with *Williams*, which is currently being reviewed by the Florida Supreme Court.
