Prisoner-appellant, Harold Joe Black, seeks review of the district court's judgment dismissing his claim that he was denied procedural due process during the course of his parole revocation hearing. A review of the record and the audio recording establishes that appellant's claim seeks a review of the Parole Board's denial of a request for parole for which no prisoner has a right of appeal. *See* La. R.S. 15:574.11. Therefore, the district court judgment is affirmed in accordance with La. U.R.C.A. Rule 2-16.2A(2)(4)(5) & (6). Appeal costs are assessed against Harold Joe Black.
